

Between two services which don't offer direct connect:

If two services each offer internet mail service, then mail can be sent between these two services using internet as a go between. For example, a CompuServe member can mail to an America Online member by using the internet address of the recipient. Example to Bob Click on America Online from Don VanSyckel on Compu-

To mail in the opposite direction the America Online member would simply use the internet access method to mail to the CompuServe member's internet address.


