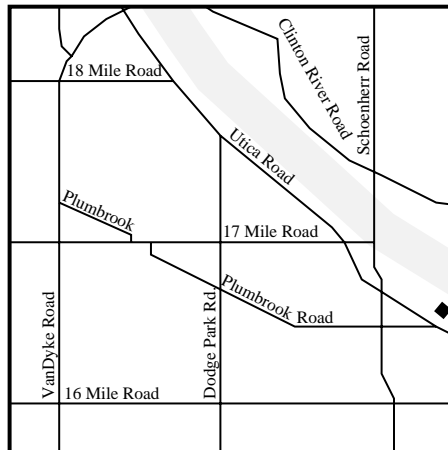

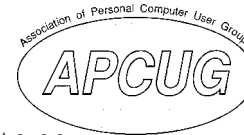
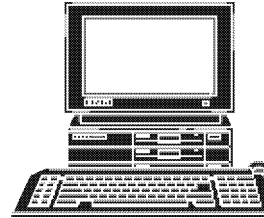

### Windows Tip

Here's a way that you can always see what time it is when you're in Windows. From the Program Manager, open the Accessories group and then double-click on the Clock icon. Click on Settings, then on Digital, and then Minimize the window (get to the Clock's Control menu, click once on the box in the upper-left corner of the Clock window, select Minimize.) Or click on the Minimize icon in the Clock's upper-right corner to achieve the same result. This places a relatively small, easy-to-read digital clock icon at the bottom of your screen. You can use the Control-menu on the icon again to select the option Always on Top option so it displays no matter what Windows application you are in.

Where <DELPHI\_ID> is the recipient's Delphi id. Example to Wendy Fisher:

Where <PRODIGY\_ID> is the recipient's Prodigy id. Example to Wendy Fisher:

If two services each offer internet mail service, then mail can be sent between these two services using internet as a go between. For example, a CompuServe member can mail to an America Online member by using the internet address of the recipient. Example to Bob Click on America Online from Don VanSyckel on Compu-
